## INSTRUCTIONS FOR WASTE MANAGEMENT FOR VESSELS

In Pietarsaari port area, instructions for waste management must be followed by taking in and handling waste from vessels and port operations. These instructions are based on laws and regulations on waste management given by the European Union and Finnish State. By following these instructions and delivering waste appropriately to waste collection stations, an environmental load caused by waste from vessels and port operations can be decreased and contaminations of marine environment prevented.

### WASTE MANAGEMENT CHARGES OF VESSELS

The currently valid tariffs are charged from all vessels in the port of Pietarsaari, except vessels exempt from the obligation to leave waste at the port. Garbage fee and no special fee for oily waste are always charged from all vessels. Oily waste and sewage, hazardous and mixed waste are charged according to actual costs added with general fee.

Violations of the instructions for waste management are liable to compensate any extra costs incurred by the port of Pietarsaari.

### WASTE RECEPTION EQUIPMENT

There are three (3) separate waste collection stations in the port area. These waste collection stations are marked with signs JÄTEASEMA – AVFALLSSTATION – WASTE STATION. The possessor of waste is obligated, supervised by the port, to deliver sorted waste to the waste collection stations.

Other Hazardous Waste	Separate containers
Oily waste and sewage	Direct receiver

It is indicated on the side of the collection point what type of waste it is intended for.

**The receipt of any waste requires an advance notice to the Port Control, p. +358 6 723 1388, portcontrol@jakobstad.fi.** Delivery must be supervised by the Port Control. It is forbidden to leave waste outside of waste collection station.

**The receipt of oily waste or sewage requires an advance notice 24 hours prior to the intended time of delivery to the Port Control, p. +358 6 723 1388, portcontrol@jakobstad.fi.**

Waste collection system of the port of Pietarsaari does not include ballast water of tankers and washing water of tanks waste originating from cargoes IMDG/ADR/RID -classes. Regarding these types of waste, vessels must order direct service from waste management company.



### RECEPTION OF CERTAIN TYPES OF WASTE

#### Dry waste (energy waste)

Dry waste includes non-recyclable paper, bags, plastics used in households, corrugated cardboard and household items like dish rags and toothbrushes.

#### Wet waste (biological waste)

Wet waste includes food leftovers, vegetable and fruit peelings, eggshells, teabags, nappies, garden waste and dust inside EU –area.

#### Mixed waste (unsorted waste)

Mixed waste includes more than 10 % of its total volume of waste from separate collection.

#### Glass

Glass products, which are suitable for recycling

#### Metal

Metal cans and sheets, covers and other clean metal.

### HAZARDOUS WASTE

#### International kitchen waste

Foodstuffs arriving from outside of EU –area.

#### Solid Oil Waste

Oily cotton waste and oil filters etc.

#### Other Hazardous Waste

Paints and glue barrels, brushes, batteries, assemblers, fluorescence tubes etc.

#### Oily Waste and Sewage

Ballast waters, waste oil, chemical waste, tankers ballast water and washings and waste, which are classified according to IMO –classes. Sanitary and toilet waters includes both grey and black waste water from social, toilet and shower areas of the vessel.
